First Woman IPS Officer

Starting a company in the healthcare industry wasn't easy. Shashank and Abhinav faced numerous challenges, from low internet penetration to gaining trust from doctors and patients. But they were determined. They started with Practo Ray, a cloud-based software that helps doctors manage their practice digitally. The software was an instant hit, helping doctors streamline their operations and focus more on patient care.

Convincing the World

One of the toughest challenges was convincing people to join their mission. But Shashank had a vision that resonated with many, and soon, the right people came on board.

His parents were supportive from the beginning, which gave him the confidence to push forward despite the hurdles. Raising funds was also challenging, but the passion and potential of Practo eventually attracted top investors like Sequoia Capital and Yuri Milner, raising \$124 million in total.

Practo is already present in Singapore, the Philippines, and Indonesia, with plans to expand to 100 cities in India and 10 countries worldwide.
